



CIVIL AIR PATROL UNIFORM MANUAL

CAPM 39-1, dated 23 March 2005, is supplemented as follows:

Table 6-4. Item 10, Column 5 (see note 3)

Added: Note 3. Distinctive unit insignia requires approval by the Illinois Wing Commander prior to the display and use.

- a. Once approved no changes in design may be made without resubmitting an insignia request through the chain-of-command for approval by the Illinois Wing Commander.
- b. Insignia designs must conform to current USAF policies and regulations with regard to shape, colors, and design elements (contact ILWG/DA for further information). Those insignia not conforming (shown below by an asterisk *) shall consult with the Illinois Wing Commander before reordering their current insignia.
- c. Units that desire approval (or design change approval) will:
 - 1) submit a high resolution color bitmap image of the insignia through the chain of command to the Illinois Wing Director of Administration (ILWG/DA).
 - 2) submit a memorandum requesting approval, which will include a description of the patch and a brief statement of the heraldry (meaning of the elements and colors in the design).
- d. Once approved by the Wing Commander the ILWG/DA will return a certificate, signed by the Wing Commander, to the requesting unit for permanent file retention.
- e. The Illinois Wing Commander authorizes wear of the following patches on flight suits and BDU's. (also see 'figure 6-20. Other Patches' for insignia image):
 - 1) Circular "Disney" wing patches (approved for wear by all members of Illinois Wing)
 - 2) National Association for Search & Rescue (NASAR) patch, Search & Rescue Technician (SARTECH) patch
 - a) Member must be a qualified CAP GTL/GTM
 - b) CAPF 2a is submitted thru channels to ILWG/DOS with documentation attached
 - 3) The following unit patches for wear by members of that unit:
