First design. The “N3933Q” at the top of the patch was the registration number of the squadron’s T-41B Mescalero aircraft. In the early 1980s, shortly after the patch was manufactured, the aircraft was destroyed in an accident and use of the patch was discontinued. 4 1/8” wide.

Second design, first variation This is the official NASA Apollo I patch. As the squadron was named in honor of the crew of Apollo I, it was adopted in their memory, September 10, 1988. 3 1/2” wide.








